BIBLE STUDY: LESSON 30

Scripture of Lesson: John 17: 1~26

1. Christ's mission: to give 'Eternal Life'

- a. v. 2 "As Thou has given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou has given him." Jesus was keenly aware of His life's mission and was ready to meet the final moments.
- b. What is 'eternal life?' v. 3 "And this is life eternal, that they might know Thee, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou has sent." Do we personally know God and Jesus Christ? When did we come to know Him in our life? Let's share our experiences.

2. Glory of God and of Christ

- a. Jesus prayed for Father's glory to go through the final moments so that He could glorify the Father [v. 1]
 - i. How did the Son glorify the Father in his life on earth?
 - V. 4 Jesus sought to glorify God during His life on earth. This was His testimony before God as He faced the final moments of suffering and death.
 - v. 6 Jesus revealed God to His disciples.
 - V. 8 He taught them God's word.
 - Luke 24: 26 "Ought not Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?"
 - ii. How can we glorify God and Jesus Christ in our lives?
 - V. 10—Christ was honored/glorified by the disciples.
 - Ps 29:1-2 "Give unto the Lord, O ye mighty; give unto the Lord glory and strength. Give unto the Lord the glory due unto His name; worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness."
 - I Peter 1: 21--"By Him ye believe in God, who raised Him up from the dead and gave Him glory, that your faith and hope might be in God."
 - I Peter 5: 11—"To Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen."
- b. Jesus drew strength to meet the final moments from His memory of the glory He had with the Father in eternity past before the world was. [v. 5]
 - i. Glory of God restrained during His life on earth—humble life as a servant of God.
 - ii. Yet He knew what was waiting for Him beyond the cruel death on the cross.
 - 1. Father and Son shared glory unspeakable in eternity past. [v. 5, 24]
 - iii. Heaven's glory is also waiting for us.
 - 1. Heavenly temple filled with God's glory: Rev. 15: 8
 - 2. Bride adorned in God's glory: Rev. 21: 11
 - 3. New Jerusalem lighted by God's glory: Rev 21:23

3. Sanctification through God's truth, word

- a. Through God's word Jesus' disciples were separated from the Jewish community as a holy, dedicated group [v. 16~19]
 - i. Holiness of God's people starts from separation in life's purpose and pursuits from the world.
- b. Christ sought to ensure the disciples [later His church] stay as one. [v. 21~23]
 - i. That they might be united in the same love of the Father and the Son [v. 24~26]
