

God's Justice in America

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Scripture for Sermon: Deuteronomy 16: 18-20 [NKJV]

18 Appoint judges and officials for each of your tribes in every town the Lord your God is giving you, and they shall judge the people fairly.

19 Do not pervert justice or show partiality. Do not accept a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and twists the words of the innocent.

20 Follow justice and justice alone, so that you may live and possess the land the Lord your God is giving you.

1. 2020 U.S. Election and God's Justice

During the past weeks since the 2020 election on November 3, there have been numerous protests, legal actions and public demonstrations of people's wills because of apparent, widespread fraudulent crimes committed during and after the election. Hundreds of evidences and affidavits of testimonies regarding fraudulent actions during the voting, vote tallying and vote count processing have been presented to the American public through public hearings, on-line media and limited news channels in spite of the willful censorship exercised by the mainstream mass media. As I am writing this message the electorate voting has occurred with GOP electors of five contending states having voted for President Trump so that we have duplicate votes from these states. The matter will go to the Congress early January in 2021 while the legal procedures are on-going.

On the other hand, there have been ample indications of the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) involvement in the election process. CCP has been proven to be the de-facto owner/controller of Dominion Voting System, which has been used in at least 29 states during the past election and now proven to have the critical design feature that allows manual manipulation of vote counting. Also, a Chinese scholar has divulged that the CCP has been conducting operations of establishing high level connections in the U.S. political stratum and specific names of leaders who have been bribed by CCP has been published. And this implication includes Joe Biden, the purported Democratic 'president-elect.' In summary, the entire U.S. as a union of states since its founding is facing a serious challenge due to the evident widespread election fraud committed by the Democratic party activities and agents and these crimes apparently were organized systematically by high level Democratic party leaders and their billionaire supporters.

At such a critical time as now, we come to wonder about God's justice and whether establishment of His justice is feasible in our nation with such a strong apparent flooding of evil in all aspects of our society. What does Bible say about God's justice? Is His justice only found in the Kingdom of Heaven but not here on the earth? What is the mission of God's people in this regard?

The above verses lay down the guideline from God to the people of Israel as they were to establish a judicial system in the land they would occupy. This guideline or principle from God has formed the fundamental principles of the western Christian nations' judicial and administrative systems. The actions of the nation's administrators and judges had to be fair to all people. Showing partiality or perversion of justice by accepting bribes was prohibited because bribes cause blindness to the judges and administrators and twisting of their judgments against the innocent. So, they were to follow justice and justice alone so as to ensure God's help.

Bible tells us that God is just. He does not need to explain why He is just because He is the Creator and Almighty God of the universe. All things that are have been created and ruled by Him. Therefore, He alone is the just God. And all His ways are just. God never does wrong and there is no injustice in His ways. That is why

God wants His people to be just as He is. He desires that the people of God exercise righteous, just judgments among themselves and towards others.

[Deuteronomy 32:4] He is the Rock, His work is perfect; For all His ways are justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He.

The fundamental tenet of Mosaic Law is “The offender must be punished commensurate with the offense.” Punishments were defined for each offense. The fundamental axiom of God’s justice is “to hate evil and to love good.”

[Amos 5:15] Hate evil, love good; Establish justice in the gate. It may be that the Lord God of hosts Will be gracious to the remnant of Joseph.

The sum of entire Mosaic Law can be summarized in this tenet – to love God, who is good, and to hate evil, which is of Satan. They were taught to worship God only, to keep His commandments so that they would be holy people as an example to all other peoples on earth. However, they were corrupted by the false religions and traditions of the ungodly gentiles of the land and were dragged far from the truth of God. God sent numerous prophets to call them to repentance, but they would not come back. God’s justice, therefore, was a companion of His mercy. He would forgive and extend mercy to them only if they would come back to Him in repentance. The same justice and mercy are extended to the peoples of the world today.

[Isaiah 30:18] Therefore, the Lord will wait, that He may be gracious to you; And therefore, He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you. For the Lord is a God of justice;

2. Will God’s Justice Be Established in America?

Lord Jesus preached that the kingdom of God had come near to the people. As we have learned in previous studies, He taught His disciples and the coming Christians that it is their calling to establish a kingdom of God wherever they are living here on earth. They are to strive so that God will, which is being done perfectly in heaven, is also achieved here on earth through the kingdom of God in our communities and nations.

[Matt 6: 9-10] In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come; Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

It is the same essential calling that the people of Israel had received from God while they were in the wilderness under Moses’ leading. It is a calling that applies to all people of God that they are to work, using the talents given to them, to bring about increases to His kingdom here on earth so that God’s will and plan are executed. The Millennial Kingdom will come most certainly. When it does come, the principles and truth of God will be fully established and practiced in all the world because it will be ruled by the King of kings and Lord of lords. Jesus Christ will be the super-president of the world government.

But He has given us a holy calling to establish a kingdom of God in each of our families, our schools, communities and nations. The notion that we have to leave God out of our schools, communities and society is an idea that Satan has successfully implanted in the minds of unbelievers. God’s people must never yield to the Satanic influences and conniving insidencies. The idea of Political Correctness (PC) is a Satan’s strategy of pushing God out of our society and nation, as implemented during the Clinton and Obama presidencies.

In spite of God’s anticipation of His justice fulfillment on the earth, just rules have been highly rare throughout the human history. Only in America, however, Christians established a nation with the motto, “*In God We Trust,*” with the intent that individual liberties including religious freedom and the freedom of assembly are guaranteed. The apparent desire of the founding fathers of America evident in the Constitution was to establish a free democratic nation where God’s principles are honored. This nation was to be a kingdom of God indeed. In spite of the Civil War conflict, the union has kept growing with God’s apparent blessings. Over the past two centuries of history America has become the greatest nation on earth as well as

the beacon and champion of free democracy to the peoples of the world, based on capitalistic economic principles and the principle of law and order that buttress its social framework.

The systematic and widespread fraud of 2020 election, however, has placed the proud tradition of America on a serious test. Hundreds of affidavit testimonies and evidences that clearly show how the deception and pre-meditated systematic fraudulent cheating in numerous states have occurred under intentional, overt, high-level supervision and politically-motivated coercion. These affidavits and evidences have been shown in public hearings and in legal proceedings to various levels of the state and federal judiciary systems. OT prophets prophesied about the nature of the Lord's kingship in the Millennial Kingdom as a just, righteous kingship, which will ensure that all sinners be punished and that all peoples shall obey the laws of God and thus live as holy peoples. While there will still be sinners in spite of the absence of the great tempter, Satan, God's justice will be implemented in all judgments and governing actions of this great kingdom.

[Psalm 45: 6-7] Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You love righteousness and hate wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions.

The apostle John foresaw the kingdom of heaven where God is on His throne, ruling and judging the whole universe. His description of God on His throne gives us a good insight into how Lord Jesus, the King of kings and Lord of lords, would sit on His throne when He returns to earth and establish His Millennial Kingdom.

[Revelation 4: 2-5; 9-11] Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne. 3 And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald. 4 Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones, I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads. 5 And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunders, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: 11 "You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

The power and majesty of the King will be supreme and cannot be challenged or opposed by any power or political forces. All powers on earth will bow down and be subject to His unique kingship and authority as the Creator and Savior of all living. The elders chosen to rule the earth as the Lord's surrogates will attribute their whole honor and adoration to the King by refusing to wear their rightful crowns of glory.

Friends, do we not wholeheartedly look forward to this great kingdom to come where the whole justice of God will be fully established and His entire Truth be honored and adored? In the meantime, however, it is our calling that we make the best use of our God-given talents to establish such a kingdom, though imperfect and yet struggling, so that God's principles and justice are honored and practiced. When the Lord returns, we will receive His "*Well done, my faithful servants!*" praise from Him. Let us pray for all brave warriors who are now fighting for the election justice in America and in South Korea, provide material support to them and plead God to send His angels so that their endeavors are fully aided from the throne above toward the worthy goal of establishing the kingdom of God on this land until the Lord returns.
